## Registration

## **Repeating Courses**

You are not permitted to register online for courses that you are repeating. You must submit an <a href="mailto:add/drop">add/drop</a> form to the Registrar's office with the course details and our office will process it. ## **Dropping courses**

You may drop courses online via MyCampus until the last day to add or drop courses with a full refund (January 20). If you are dropping your last course you must do so in person at the Registrar's office, U5 portable, Room 68 (north location) or 61 Charles Street, Room DTA 121 (downtown location).

## Tuition deadline is January 9, 2012

The best way to pay your tuition fees, compulsory ancillary fees and program associated fees is by bank payment, using Internet or telephone banking, or in person at your bank. UOIT does not accept payment of tuition fees, compulsory ancillary fees and program associated fees by credit card, debit, non-certified cheque or cash. ### Winter semester - important dates

January 2, 2012 University re-opens.

January 9 to January 13, 2012 Winter term start days for all consecutive and fifth-

year concurrent education students.

January 9, 2012 Lectures begin, winter semester. Deadline for payment of fees, winter semester. January 20, 2012 End of regular registration period; last day to add courses, winter semester. Last day to drop courses and receive a 100 per cent refund of tuition fees, winter semester. After this date, you must complete a course add/drop form and submit it to the Registrar's office in order to drop course(s). February 3, 2012 Last day to withdraw from winter semester courses without academic consequences (i.e. without receiving a grade). Courses dropped after this date will be recorded on the academic transcript with a grade of W to indicate withdrawal. Last day to drop courses and receive a 50 per cent refund of tuition fees, winter semester. February 20, 2012 Family Day, no lectures. February 20 to February 24, 2012 Midterm break. February 28, 2012 Last day to submit online application for graduation for the spring session of convocation for students completing degree requirements at the end of the winter semester.

March 21, 2012

Last day to withdraw from winter semester courses.

As of March 22, students may not drop courses or withdraw. Active winter semester courses will be graded by instructors.

April 6, 2012 Good Friday, no lectures.

April 13, 2012 Lectures end, winter semester.

April 16 to 27, 2012 Winter semester final examination period. Students are advised not to make commitments during this period (i.e. vacation, travel plans).
