

Notice regarding transit service during the holiday season

Dear UOIT student,

As the fall academic term winds up, fewer passengers travel by public transit to and from university and college campuses. Many transit agencies are gradually decreasing extra service. Some also temporarily increase or revise services during the examination period. Also be aware that many local transit agencies decrease or eliminate extra service during the period from Friday, December 24 through Sunday, January 2, 2011 (inclusive).

For example, starting Monday, December 13, GO Transit will be scaling back extra service to UOIT. Students are strongly advised to closely check for revised schedules for each agency throughout the holiday period:
