What you need to know about the Financial Aid/Bursary

The Durham Muslim Student's Financial Aid/Bursary, is assistance based on merit and financial need, intended to aid Muslim students in attaining their educational goals. Eligible applicants include those who are currently pursuing a diploma, undergraduate degree or graduate degree, or will be entering into either of the latter degree programs in the following academic year. Students applying for this bursary should meet the eligibility requirements listed below:

(1) Students must be in financial need, as determined by, the Committee overlooking the applications

- (2) Students must be in good academic standing/have a competitive GPA
- (3) Students must be enrolled at the University of Ontario Institute of Technology
- or Durham College

To apply for the Durham Muslim Student's Financial Aid/Bursary, students must submit the following to the Committee:

(1)One copy of an up to date transcript (high school students entering their first year must submit their high school final report card) in a sealed envelope, preferably sent directly from the institution

(2)One copy of a resume

(3)A completed Questionnaire form

- (4)Two reference forms, completed by two separate individuals (references cannot be family members or friends)
- (5) One passport sized photograph

**Please note: ALL of the above must be typed and not hand written, with the exception of reference forms
