TERMS AND CONDITIONS

WHEREAS:

The Seller desires to sell various assets under the terms and conditions set forth below;

The Buyer desires to purchase the assets offered for sale by the Seller under the terms and conditions set forth below; and

NOW THEREFORE In consideration of the mutual promises and other valuable considerations exchanged between the parties set forth herein, the Parties, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

Description of Assets:

The following table or description describes the asset(s) being sold by the Seller to the Buyer pursuant to this Agreement. These assets will hereinafter be referred to as the "Acquired Assets".

Purchase Price:

The total purchase price payable by the Buyer to Seller for the "Acquired Assets" is \$XXXXXX plus applicable taxes (hereinafter "Purchase Price")

Terms and Conditions:

The Buyer shall be entitled to retain the Acquired Assets subject to its fulfilment of the terms of this Contract.

The Buyer shall be responsible for all transportation related to the Acquired Assets and the terms will be FOB Origin Freight collect.

The Buyer hereby releases and forever discharges Seller, its directors, officers, employees and agents and their respective personal representatives, successors and assigns (each, a "Releasee") from any and all actions, causes of actions, suits, proceedings, rights, claims and demands whatsoever, whether at law or in equity, which the Buyer may now or in the future have against any Releasee as a result of, in respect of or arising out of the donation, use, sale, lease, disposition or possession of the Acquired Assets. The Buyer shall not commence or maintain any action or proceeding of any kind whatsoever against any person in which anything hereby released could be claimed against any Releasee by way of contribution or indemnity or otherwise.

The Buyer shall indemnify and save harmless Seller, its directors, officers, employees and agents and their respective personal representatives, successors and assigns (each, an "Indemnified Party") from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, causes of action, damages, losses, costs (including legal fees), liabilities or expenses (including amounts paid in settlement of any such matters) which may be made or brought against any Indemnified Party and/or which any Indemnified Party may suffer or incur as a result of, in respect of or arising out of the donation, use, sale, lease, disposition or possession of the Acquired Assets by the Buyer or any third party, or any breach by the Buyer of its obligations under this Contract.

The seller shall not be liable for any consequential damages, lost profits, lost savings, loss of anticipated revenue or any exemplary, punitive, special or indirect damages arising from or in any way connected to this Contract, even if advised of the possibility of such damages.

The Buyer agrees and acknowledges that it is accepting the Acquired Assets on an 'as is' condition from the Seller.

This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior representations, agreements, understandings, negotiations and discussions, whether written or oral. There are no conditions, covenants, agreements, representations, warranties or other provisions, expressed or implied, collateral, statutory or otherwise, relating to the subject matter hereof except as herein provided.

This Contract shall be governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein.

This Contract shall inure to the benefit of and shall be binding on and enforceable by the parties and their respective successors and permitted assigns. Seller may at any time assign any of all of its rights or obligations hereunder. The Buyer may not assign any of its rights or obligations hereunder without the prior written consent of the Seller.

This Contract may be executed in any number of counterparts and by different parties in separate counterparts, each of which when so executed shall be deemed to be an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same agreement. Delivery by electronic transmission in portable document form (PDF) of an executed counterpart of this Contract is as effective as delivery of an originally executed counterpart of this Contract.

How do I know that the PC is working, as it has no Operating System?

Only decommissioned Gaming PCs that were verified as working are being offered for sale. Once powered up all the PCs should start and arrive at the 'Dos Prompt' from where a new Operating System of your choice can be installed.

What are these PCs good to be used for ideally?

These PCs are high performance machines and are ideally suited for gaming, graphics and development applications

What are examples of past operating systems or applications that were previously run on the gaming PCs?

- The last operating system was Windows 7 64-bit Enterprise
- Examples of some applications used were in the category of graphics and gaming including: e.g. Adobe Creative Cloud, Autodesk Entertainment Creation Suite, Corel Painter, World Machine 2.3 Pro, Xbox 360 controller drivers

I understand that no Durham College PC support or warranty is available for the PCs, can I utilize a manufacturers extended warranty?

Unfortunately, all Manufacturers' warranties have also expired for these systems. You can consult with a private technician or repair facility external to Durham College regarding any required technical assistance or configuration.

Can I approach the Service Desk with a quick question regarding the systems?

NO. Do not engage the Service Desk or other IT staff in support questions regarding the system. Your agreement highlights that you understand that you are to engage any required support outside of Durham College. DC tech staff must maintain focus on their regular tasks.

Do these PCs support an Apple platform?

No. These are windows based PCs.

Can I return the PC if it's not what I wanted?

You have 24 hours in which to return the PC. Take a careful look at your used PC needs before purchase, to be sure that this is what you require. No refunds will be processed after 24 hours.

How should I transport my computer?

Ideally you will need a vehicle to transport your gaming computer (please see the weight of your preferred unit). The computer should be loaded into your vehicle preferably from the D wing parking lot.
