



Engineering and Management

If you are enrolled in your third year of study in an Engineering program you are eligible to apply for the Management program. In the Management program, you will take an additional year of business courses (30 credits) and the notation “and Management” will appear on your degree.

With additional expertise in business and management, graduates of these programs will have a broader understanding of the business and management aspects of companies, allowing them to readily take on managerial roles or start their own businesses.

Students take the fourth year of their engineering program in Year 5.

If you would like to apply for the Management program, fill out a [Change of Program and Management application](#) and submit it to the Registrar's office by **Thursday, April 10, 2014**. Please note that late applications will not be accepted.

Key information:

- Applications due Thursday April 10, 2014 for the September 2014 term
- Seats are limited, and assigned on a competitive entry basis
- You must have successfully completed at least 54 credit hours and hold a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.3
- Those accepted will commence the courses as of Fall 2014, so may not take Spring/Summer courses
- Course offerings are based on 2014/15 programming and are subject to change at the discretion of the Faculties.
