

Science and Management

If you are enrolled in your third or fourth year of study in the Faculty of Science you are eligible to apply for the Management program. In the Management program, you will take an additional year of business courses (30 credits) and the notation "and Management" will appear on your degree.

The combination of a science degree and business and management education will give an added advantage to graduates who are interested in pursuing managerial roles or starting their own business.

The Science and Management programs follow the same program map as the four-year degree regular program and the five-year co-operative education program with the addition of the following 10 courses in Year 5 or 6 respectively.

Semester 1

Semester 2

If you would like to apply for the Management program, fill out a <u>Change of Program</u> and <u>Management application</u> and submit it to the Registrar's office by Thursday, April 10, 2014. Please note that late applications will not be accepted with the exception of students in their fourth year of study. Key information:

- Applications due Thursday April 10, 2014 for the September 2014 term
- Seats are limited and assigned on a competitive entry basis
- You must have successfully completed at least 54 credit hours and hold a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.3
- Those accepted will commence the courses as of Fall 2014, so may <u>not</u> take Spring/Summer courses
- Course offerings are based on 2014/15 programming and are subject to change at the discretion of the Faculties.
