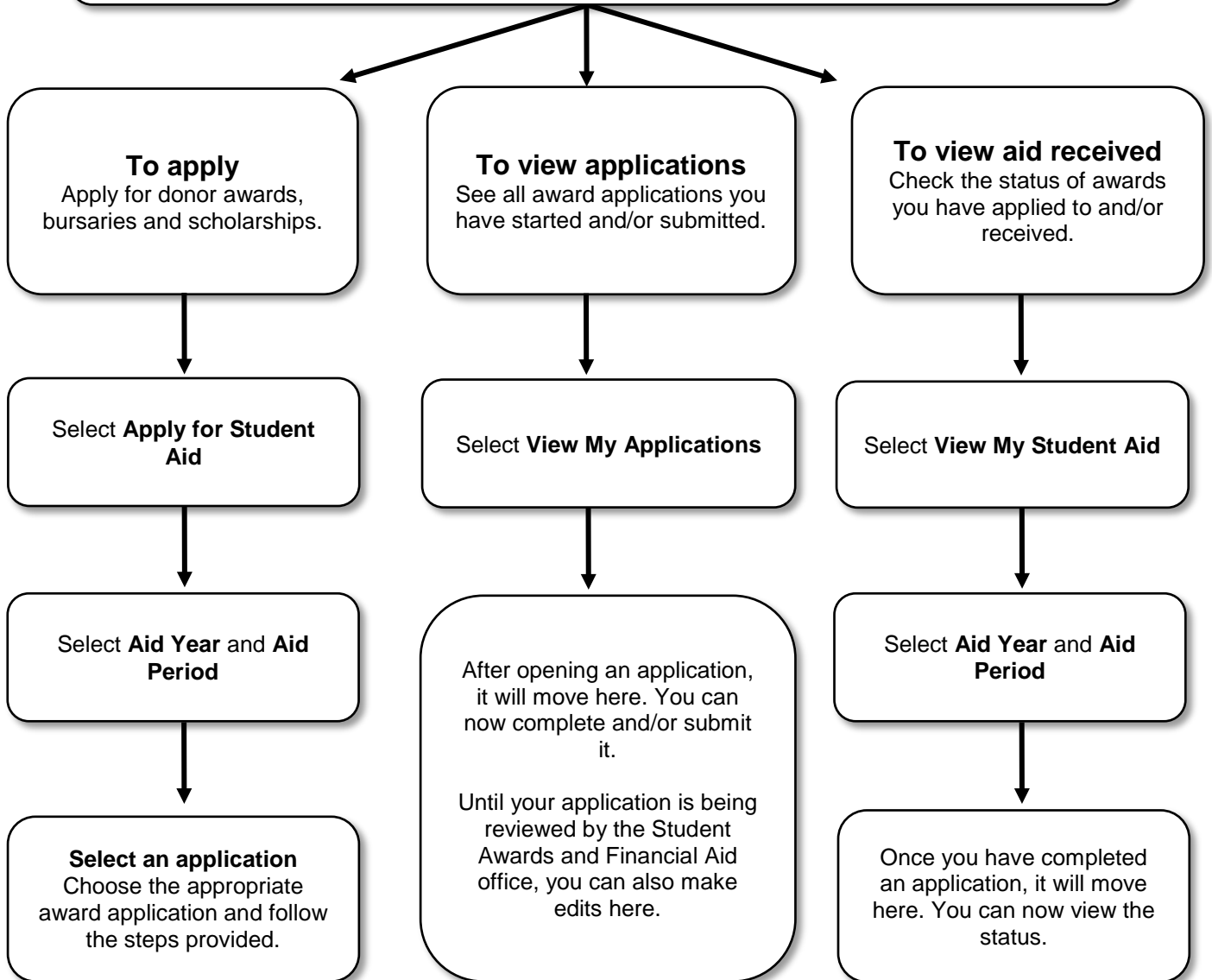


Log in to MyCampus by going to uoit.ca/mycampus. Go to the **Awards and Financial Aid** tab, then click on the **Start My Application** link under the **Bursary Applications** section.



Find the right donor award for you

It is easy to find all of the donor awards you are eligible for by using the **Find a Donor Award** search engine. Start applying as soon as applications become available through MyCampus on the Awards and Financial Aid tab (two months prior to the application deadline).

Follow these three quick steps:

1. Access the **Find a Donor Award** search on safa.uoit.ca.
2. Select award type, faculty and year of study.
3. In the **Select an award** drop-down menu, you will be able to see the scholarships and bursaries you may be eligible for.

Frequently asked questions

What is the difference between a scholarship and a bursary?

A scholarship is awarded based on academic excellence, though involvement in extracurricular activities or in the community may also be considered. Bursaries are based on financial need, but may also have other eligibility criteria.

How is financial need determined?

Financial need is determined based on the information you provide in the General Bursary and Donor Award Application.

Is it possible to receive both scholarships and bursaries?

Of course! We strongly encourage you to apply for all scholarships and bursaries you are eligible for; however, some restrictions may apply.

How will I receive my award funding?

The most frequent method of payment is a posting directly to your student account. Some awards will be issued to you by cheque. If a cheque is being issued, you will receive personal directions on how to pick up your cheque through your UOITnet email.
